In addition, the sprinkler main shall be disinfected in accordance with the requirements of AWWA C651 and two bacteriological tests shall be taken 24 hours apart. The results of the bacteriological test results must indicate there are no coliform bacteria present.

NOTE: The Water Board or Water Superintendent may require other specific data or information.
