### Voting with Disability Accommodations

The Vermont Election Laws are designed to, “provide equal opportunity for all citizens of voting age to participate in political processes” 17 V.S.A. § 2101.

#### Your Voting Rights

- ★ The right to vote (if otherwise qualified)
- ★ The right to access your polling place
- ★ The right to receive reasonable accommodations for your disability

#### Receiving a Ballot

- ★ Two Justices can bring a ballot to your home
- ★ Curbside voting is available upon request
- ★ Absentee ballots can be either taken home to vote on or mailed to the voter

#### Assistance at the Polls

- ★ Can bring a person of your choice to help you vote
- ★ Can ask two election officials for assistance

#### Assistive Devices

- ★ May bring a candidate sheet/reminder sheet
  - ★ This cannot be left behind in the polling place
- ★ May bring magnifying glass or other devices to assist in marking the ballot
