Voting with Disability Accommodations

The Vermont Election Laws are designed to, "provide equal opportunity for all citizens of voting age to participate in political processes" 17 V.S.A. § 2101.

Your Voting Rights

- The right to vote (if otherwise qualified)
- The right to access your polling place
- The right to receive reasonable accommodations for your disability

Receiving a Ballot

- Two Justices can bring a ballot to your home
- Curbside voting is available upon request
- Absentee ballots can be either taken home to vote on or mailed to the voter

Assistance at the Polls

- Can bring a person of your choice to help you vote
- Can ask two election officials for assistance

Assistive Devices

- May bring a candidate sheet/reminder sheet
 - ★ This cannot be left behind in the polling place
- May bring magnifying glass or other devices to assist in marking the ballot
